- 2) Must actively participate in Community Service, Americanism, Safety and Youth Activities both in the Post and in the Community.
- 3) Must be present at Post sponsored programs such as Veterans Day, Memorial Day, POW/MIA day and any other patriotic events that are held in both the Post and the community.
- 4) The conduct of the member in the Post and the community must exemplify a positive im- age which adds to the prestige of the Veterans of Foreign Wars.
- 5) The member, who by example, motivates others to become more involved in Post and community activities.
- 6) Member must attend Post meetings, District meetings and at least one (1) Council of Administration meeting.
- 7) Must have attended either a District or Department a School of Instruction.
