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

Membership Mission

To recruit, retain and mentor a strong membership base that is all-inclusive regardless of age, race, gender, and religious beliefs.

To grow a membership well versed in the mission of the VFW including grassroots and program knowledge, members that are active at all levels of the organization to include Department activities and local communities.

Introduction

The #1 priority for South Carolina in 2025-2026 is to refocus our posts and members in the areas of active recruiting, and to work towards the goal of retaining and upgrading membership throughout the entire state.

Success starts at the Post level: each post must have a strong membership chairman, as well as a committee that coordinates with the District and Department membership chairmen. Their goals and purpose are to help coordinate recruiting events, while working with Posts to make their membership program successful.

For those who are a Post, District or Department line officer we need to focus on the following:

- Show our members how it should be done, by getting out there and leading by example
- Demonstrate how to recruit and retain members ourselves
- Use all means necessary to reach out to potential new members and retain our current comrades, using modern technology like social media, emails, calling and / or texting.

Membership Goals

- 1. Continue to build strong membership programs at the Post, District and Department levels, while working with the Department Membership Chairman. We need to work together to reach the goals set for membership with constant communication and participation.
- 2. Continue to work together and promote all of our VFW Programs. Most importantly, we need to be visible in the community: doing fund raisers; attending local community events; recruiting new members; participating in Buddy Poppy Drives.

Membership Objectives

- 1. Every member should recruit and mentor one new member.
- 2. Every Post needs to renew current members with retention being 50% or higher.
- 3. Increase Life and Legacy Memberships.
- 4. Increase and improve membership drives throughout the State.
- 5. Develop new Posts, and / or revitalize existing Posts.

Legacy Membership

Any post reaching 15 new legacy members or increasing their legacy life membership by 15 members in 2025-2026 will be awarded \$250.

Membership Notes and Contacts

- Awards given to a Post may be transferred to any member of that Post.
- No more than one stipend will be awarded to an individual for a given event.
- Posts, Districts, and Departments must reach a minimum of 101% membership to qualify for any award.
- Employees and officers of the VFW National Headquarters are excluded from receiving stipends or awards in this program unless otherwise authorized by the State Commander and the Quartermaster.

Membership Trophy

During each Counsel of Administration meeting the membership trophy will go to the district that has the highest membership percentage. It will be determined by the percentages at the end of the last quarter

- 1. The district with the highest membership percentage on 6/30/2026 will receive a Top District 2025-2026 trophy for the district to commemorate the accomplishment.
- 2. The District Commander will also receive a plaque to commemorate the accomplishment.
- 3. The post with the highest membership percentage on 6/30/2024 will receive a Top Post 2025-2026 trophy for the post to commemorate the accomplishment.
- 4. The Post Commander will also receive a plaque to commemorate the accomplishment.

New Post Development

For each new post created the department will provide \$300 toward necessary materials for that new post.

Golden Pen Award

Posts that have completed all required tasks on the All-American Dashboard, have turned their bonding paperwork and audits in correctly and on time and are at 95% membership by 12/31/2025 will have their Adjutant entered into a drawing for the Golden Pen Award.

The drawing of this award will be at the first staff meeting of 2026. This award is an engraved pen set. It will be presented at the Mid-Winter Conference in January along with a \$100 Gift Certificate to the VFW Store.

Life Saving Awards

YOUTH LIFE SAVING, LINE OF DUTY LIFE SAVING, VALOR LIFE SAVING AWARD

CRITERIA:

- Documentation of the event such as newspaper clippings, etc.
- Name of the individual receiving the award.
- Date of presentation to be held.
- Name and address of the Post Commander or Auxiliary President who will be presenting the award.

1. YOUTH LIFE SAVING AWARD

- The age group for this award is seventeen (17) and under.
- To honor individuals who without regard for their own comfort and whose actions resulted in the saving of another human life.

2. LINE OF DUTY LIFE SAVING AWARD

To honor individuals who in the execution of their assigned duties have acted resulting in the saving
of another human life.

3. VALOR LIFE SAVING AWARD

- The age group for this award is eighteen (18) and over.
- This award honors civilians who acted resulting in the saving of another human life and have placed their own safety at risk.

1st Place awards in all three categories will be presented to the Post Commander at the Mid-Winter Conference.

The Post will present the award at a venue chosen by the award recipient and outside the VFW to maximize public exposure of these awards such as at a city council meeting etc. are highly encouraged.

- Outstanding achievement in community service and/or the cadet program
- Outstanding leadership in the cadet program
- High moral character
- Exceptional professionalism in appearance and actions (Officer Award)
- Outstanding military bearing and conduct in and out of uniform (NCO Award)
- Involvement in patriotic programs, drill team, color guard, etc.
- Demonstrated potential and willingness to assume higher levels of responsibility

ADDITIONAL CRITERIA FOR JROTC

- Positive attitude toward the ROTC program
- For JROTC, must be enrolled as a 10th 12th grade JROTC student
- Must maintain a "B" average in ROTC curriculum and a "C" average in all remaining subjects with no failing grades in the previous semester
- Active in at least one other student extracurricular activity (music, athletics, government, etc.)

A plaque and \$100.00 cash award will be presented to the Department winner.

SOCIAL MEDIA CONTENT MUST HAVE STRONG EMPHASIS PROVIDING THE FOLLOWING:

CRITERIA

- 1. A strong emphasis on membership is important:
 - a. e.g. dues reminders to members, application for membership requirements
 - b. Contacts for a potential new member to call.
- 2. District/Post Newsletter:
 - a. It is important to post current newsletters on your social media.
 - b. Post monthly calendar to promote participation. Emphasize special projects and patriotic events.
- 3. Post descriptions of National, Department, District, Post programs and events:
 - a. Explanation of VFW, District, Post programs and their importance.
 - b. Due dates, to who and where to submit applications.
- 4. Community Service events.
 - a. Descriptions of the event with dates.
 - b. Pictures with captions tell a story and help to explain the event.
- 5. Special Events
 - a. Memorial Day, Veterans Day, VFW events with pictures.
- 6. Contact information Your Social Media page is the way to get the word out about your District and Post. Current contact information attracts members and guests to your site.
 - a. Post meeting times.
 - b. Post address and business hours.
 - c. A picture of the Post Home Showing where we live is useful to attract potential new members to the District or your Post.

The Department Webmaster will be the sole judge for this award, no letters of recommendation are required.

Content updated with current information will be a strong indicator for judging.

This award is separated into two categories, District and Post. One award will be presented in each category. The award will be presented at a conference or regular Council of Administration meeting.

Social Media submissions are based on the calendar year January 1, 2025 to December 31, 2025.
