- Please be advised that the Online Membership System (OMS) will be shutting down at 4:00 p.m. CST on Dec. 31, 2023. Any transactions that are submitted through OMS on Dec. 31, up to the closing time, will be posted to Memstats and Post Query later that evening and available for viewing the morning of Jan. 5, 2024.
- Mail received at the National Headquarters prior to Dec. 29, 2023, will be processed and counted in the December total. Mail received after that date, regardless of the postmark date, will not be counted in the December total. We suggest you have your Posts mail in their membership as early as possible or take advantage of the Online Membership System tools.
- The OMS system will be back online for the submittal of transactions by 4:00 p.m. CST, Jan. 1, 2024; however, membership transactions that are processed will not be posted to Memstats until all pertinent data is secured and verified. This should occur on (or before) Jan. 8, 2024.

• Department Inspections: We are moving forward with the Department Inspection initiative for the 2023-2024 term and have plans to complete ten (10) inspections this year. - There are currently 49 Posts under suspension, six of which are new. We have processed one Post consolidation pursuant to Section 209 of the National Bylaws. The organization has 5,664 chartered Posts.
- Administrative Operations is engaged in 20 Article IX Disciplinary Actions, 16 Administrative Actions and nine membership eligibility challenges.
- We have 50 Bylaws/Articles of Incorporation submissions in for review, 19 of which are new; current turnaround time on Bylaws/Articles of Incorporation submissions is approximately 30 days.

National Legislative Service

 VFW Tells Subcommittee to Streamline Appeals Process: VFW National Veterans Service Director Michael Figlioli testified at a House Subcommittee on Disability Assistance and Memorial Affairs oversight hearing to examine the VA appeals process. Figlioli stated the VFW's views on how to improve decision-making processes at the VA Board of Veterans' Appeals (BVA) and the United States Court of Appeals for Veterans Claims. "It is the VFW's position that communication and coordination between the BVA, Veterans Benefits Administration (VBA), and accredited representatives are critical during the remand process," he said. "Clear and concise directives that the decision-maker must comply with from the BVA to the VBA help streamline the further development of cases." He continued, "Effective collaboration between these entities is essential to ensure that the remand process serves its intended purpose without unnecessary complications and needless delays." <u>Read</u> <u>the testimony</u> or <u>watch the hearing</u>, which begins at the 7:43 mark.
