Administrative Operations

- There are currently 33 Posts under suspension; two of which are new with four suspensions lifted since last week. We are working to institute one new Post pursuant to Sections 201 of the National Bylaws. The organization has 5,743 chartered Posts.
- Administrative Operations is engaged in 24 Article IX Disciplinary Actions, 14 administrative actions and eight membership eligibility challenges.
- Our new completely digital process for reviewing bylaws and articles of incorporation at all levels is working well. We received 22 new sets of bylaws and articles of incorporation; we reviewed 40 and have 41 awaiting review.
- We are processing election reports as quickly as we receive them. This is a reminder that the quickest and easiest way to submit election reports is by utilizing the Quartermaster's tools within the Online Membership System (OMS).
- To date we have received 3,490 Post election reports and 149 District election reports. 2,253 Posts, or 39%, still have not submitted an election report. Any Post that has not submitted an election report by June 1 is in arrears; will be prevented from voting at their respective Department convention; and will be subject to suspension/revocation.
