Administrative Operations

- There are currently 45 Posts under suspension, two of those are new. Over the last week, this office has one pending and completed two Post charter surrenders and has completed one Post charter revocation pursuant to Sections 210, and 212 of the National Bylaws respectively. The organization currently has 5,862 active chartered Posts.
- Administrative Operations is engaged in 16 Article IX Disciplinary Actions, one administrative action and five pending membership eligibility challenges.
- This past week we received nine new Bylaws/Articles of Incorporation submissions in for review. We reviewed and approved 10 total Bylaws/Articles of Incorporation submissions and currently have two submissions pending review and approval. Current turnaround time on Bylaws/Articles of Incorporation submissions is approximately 14 days.
- There are still <u>939</u> Posts with missing or incomplete election reports. Pursuant to Section 213 of the National Bylaws, these Posts shall be deprived of all representation in County Council and District meetings, and County Council, District, Department and National Conventions. Such representation shall be restored promptly upon proper submission of their Election Report. <u>Per the Commander-in-Chief, Posts that have not submitted an election report by July 1 will be subject to suspension pursuant to Section 211 of the National Bylaws and Manual of Procedure.</u>

• The VFW's longtime supporter Humana is tackling the ever-growing problem of social isolation through the innovative Far From Alone Program. National Legislative Service

- VFW Washington Office Executive Director Bob Wallace and VFW National Legislative Service Deputy Director Tammy Barlet were in attendance at the White House as President Biden signed into law three VFW-supported bills. The <u>Dr. Kate Hendricks Thomas</u> <u>SERVICE Act</u> will expand eligibility for VA mammography screenings to veterans who served in certain areas during specific time periods. The <u>Making Advances in Mammography</u> <u>and Medical Options for Veterans Act</u> will address provisions of mammograms and breast cancer treatment within VA. Lastly, <u>Strengthening Oversight for Veterans Act of 2021</u> gives the VA Office of Inspector General the authority to subpoen the attendance and testimony of witnesses as needed. <u>Watch the bill signing</u>.
- The Program of Comprehensive Assistance for Family Caregivers (PCAFC) annual reassessments have been suspended by VA. Stipends will not be discharged or reduced during the suspension period. The PCAFC program continues to review its requirements and procedures to ensure the program benefits veterans and caregivers. All other application processes, assessments, appeals, and reviews will continue while the procedures are under evaluation. <u>Read more</u>.
- To ensure patient safety, VA has introduced COVID-19 Health Protection Levels to provide clear and accommodating guidelines regarding community spread. Low, medium, and high levels based on the local CDC's community transmission rate are monitored and updated weekly. Notifications will be placed at all facility entrances, and on the local facility website and social media channels. <u>Read more</u>.
- Interest rates as high as 189% are impacting military-connected consumers and families who are using certain loans to pay for auto repairs and even pets. In some cases, loan terms appear to violate or sidestep existing laws like the <u>Military Lending Act</u> (MLA), which caps many consumer loan interest rates at 36% for those serving on active duty. All consumers are reminded to exercise caution when making financial choices. <u>Read more</u>.
- The VFW currently <u>supports 169 bills</u>; and <u>opposes one bill</u> pending before the 117th Congress.
