The Convention is over, the State and Auxiliary elected and appointed officers have been chosen and sworn in. Now it is time for your new State Commander to take the reins and lead us into 2025-2026 by administering to the affairs of and transacting the business of the Department.....WRONG!

ARTICLE V, Section 522(b) says: the COUNCIL of ADMINISTRATION "SHALL" be responsible for <u>administering the affairs and transacting the business</u> of the Department between Department Conventions!

In the case of South Carolina, that CofA consists of about 18 people, including the Commander (those that constitute the CofA can be found in Section 522(a) of the National By Laws).

Some of the State affairs the CofA is responsible for are:

1)Budget, 2)Audit Department Accounts, 3)Disposition of Property, 4)Schedule/Attend 2 meetings a year (ensuring an acceptable quorum with a one member one vote allowance).

Commander Haviland's specific duties are outlined in the Manual of Procedure, ARTICLE V, Section 518(a)(1)

Most of you did not see it, but the SENTINEL earned a VFW National award this year (for a 2024 submission) for being the second-best publication (all categories) in all the VFW.

Getting the word out

I have always been a firm believer in keeping VFW members informed. Something that I believe is drastically lacking at most levels of the VFW. How do you get the word out to that 95, 90, 75% of your membership that does not attend your monthly business meeting, or District meeting? With my being appointed Editor, With the support of Commander Haviland, I want to reestablish the recognition program that I had in years past. I am asking that any Post or District that is producing a Newsletter, that you will send me a copy of your publication. For Posts, any Post that submits at least three (3) Newsletters during this year, or any District that submits at least two (2) newsletters during this year, will receive some form of a Certificate of Recognition (presented at the 2026 Convention). Any Post or District that shows continued use of a Webpage or Facebook page to get the word out, will also be recognized.
