Why do we have this program?

- Post requirement for All-State and All-American
 - \$100.00 minimum donation
- Recruiting Tool
- Connects our Comrades with current service members, veterans and potential members of the VFW and the VFW Auxiliary

What is VMS?

Comprised of Troop Support and Military Assistance Program (MAP)

- Troop Support Program
 - Assist troops and their families during deployments, send off events and welcome home events.
 - Engage with military units in your area.

- Military Assistance Program (MAP) Connection between the local VFW and the military community
 - MAP Grants What are they?
 - Financial assistance given to a Post or Auxiliary for troop support activities.
 - Who can apply?
 - Departments, Posts or Auxiliaries
 - What type of events can the MAP Grant be used for?
 - Family Days, Picnics, BBQ's, Welcome Home and Deployment Ceremonies, Holidays and Festivals
 - Cannot be used for public events or formal military events.
 - What can be purchased with MAP Grant Funds?
 - Basic food and non-alcoholic beverages for current military members and their families ONLY.

- Military Assistance Program (MAP) continued....
 - Where can you get a MAP Grant application?
 - <u>www.vfw.org</u>, my VFW tab and then VFW Training and Support under General Member Tools, select Veterans and Military Support.
 - When should you submit a MAP Grant application?
 - No earlier than 14 days prior to the event.
 - Must provide receipts and detailed description

- Adopt-A-Unit
 - Who can adopt a unit?
 - Posts and Auxiliaries or combination of both.
 - Why adopt a unit?
 - Supports local military and their families
 - Connects military members to the VFW
 - Recruit! Recruit!!!!
 - Make a Big Deal about it.
 - What kind of activities can you plan?
 - Welcome Home, Deployment, Yellow Ribbon, Family Day, Meetings, CoC, Funeral/Memorial Services
 - Only limited by your imagination.

- Adopt-A-Unit continued
 - How do you apply to Adopt-A-Unit
 - Make contact with the unit you wish to adopt.
 - Make contact with VMSP Chair if need be.
 - Complete the Adopt-A-Unit application at www.vfw.org/troopsupport
 - Annual Report (Between 1 July and 30 June)
 - Minimum of 1 after action report must be submitted annually per adopted unit.
 - Can submit a report after each event.


Military Assistance Program (MAP)

 - Statewide: Multiple SCNG Armories


Updating the Dashboard

 - 914 VMS events held. (-36% from 2022-2023)
 - \$115,166.83 donated or contributed to Veterans. (-13% from 2022-2023)
- Adopt a Unit 2023-2024
- Began with 11 Post's participating
- Ended with 5
- 6 AAU events held
- \$3,200 obtained from National (-32% from 2022-2023)
