PURPOSE

DURATION:

From now through January 31, 2023, donations made at the post level up to each district will go toward the VFW National Home. Each Post/District help earn Points in the challenge and credited for dollars toward the VFW National Home on the Department Dashboard. We'll tally and provide monthly reports of District placements!

EARNING POINTS:

Using the 2021–2022-year total Comrade members by District (because we know everyone will be at least 100% in 2022-2023), we established a pro-rated District Point System so ALL DISTRICTS have an equal opportunity in this challenge. (See Point System chart on page 2)

THE REWARD:

The biggest reward will be the VFW National Home when our liaison, State Jr. Vice Commander, Janet Chisolm-Richard visits at the end of the administrative year to present a sizable check on behalf of the VFW Department of South Carolina.

The District with the most Challenge Points will receive a reward and recognition at both the 2023 Department Mid-Winter Conference and June Convention.

CALCULATING POINTS:

2021-2022 Membership Strength, the smallest, **District 6** at **392** = **\$1.00**. In each additional District for \$Prorated Amount, District **Member Strength / 392** = **\$Prorated Amount**. Points, District **\$Prorated Amount** X **\$Contributions Made** = **Challenge Points**. *In the Example Chart below, District 5 would lead the pack with 66.866 points*.
